SPORT


Mission: ensures that fair, capably regulated and above all safe events are conducted in all corners of the globe.

MOBILITY

Mission: ensure that safe, affordable and clean systems of transport are available to all.







Fit for 55 Package

- Published on 14 July
- Aim: to reduce net GHG emissions by 2030 by at least 55%, compared to 1990 levels
- Set of <u>inter-connected proposals</u>, covering climate, energy, transport, and taxation

EC Impact Assessment. Average output power 15Kw

1. Effort sharing

AFIR sets more ambitious targets for MS:

• Expands publicly accessible charging capacity - two-step approach:

- Fleet-based
- **60km intervals** on major highways
- Set transparency obligations on pricing and payments options
- $\circ~$ Publicly accessible recharging to be capable of smart charging



2. Increase vehicle efficiency:

- CO2 emission standards: 2030 (-55%) and 2035 (-100%) to accelerate the production and sales of EVs
- **RED**: Increased amounts of <u>**Renewable</u> electricity** to propel EVs</u>



European Commission's 'Fit for 55' Package Main elements (road transport)



3. Carbon pricing:

- **ETS** to put a price on carbon to incentivize cleaner energy
- Electricity to be among the least taxed energy sources to foster its use in transport
- Social Climate Fund to support EVs uptake



BEUC's study on electric car ownership – 2021

- A medium-sized EV bought today is already the most financially interesting solution over the car's lifetime – especially for large mileage drivers
- Plug-in hybrids and cars powered with e-fuels bring little to no benefit
- Future 2nd and 3rd hand owners will make savings for each EVs car sold today



European Commission's 'Fit for 55' Package ICE vehicle de facto ban?



'By 2050, emissions from **transport need to decrease by 90%.** The **transition** to a greener and smarter mobility system has begun, but it **needs to be accelerated'**



De facto ban to the ICE vehicle?

Strengthened CO2 emissions standards will lead to **zero** tailpipe **emissions vehicles** of the **new fleet** as from 2035

By 2050, EC affirms that nearly all cars EU on roads will need to be Zero Emissions



European Commission's 'Fit for 55' Package ICE vehicle de facto ban?

In parallel

Countries, regions and cities are already introducing restrictions to diesel and petrol Vehicles

On top of that, some **Vehicle manufacturers** announced they will **stop the production/ development** of new **petrol and diesel** cars in the EU as of 2026







European Commission's 'Fit for 55' Package FIA Region I vision

In this regards, our concerns are the following:

For the **transition** to be **effective**, **efficient** and **inclusive**, it **needs to be**:

✓ Technology neutral approach open to a full array of technology options

- ✓ Promote use of alternative fuels through infrastructure instead of taxes/restrictions
- Empower consumers to inform themselves & verify vehicle environmental performance
- ✓ Mitigate the impact on vulnerable citizens

In order words, the strategy will need to get consumers onboard
