THE NAVLYPROJECT: A LONG-TERM EXPERIMENTATION

- Launched in **September 2016**
- Two autonomous vehicles deployed
- Capacity: **15 passengers** / shuttle
- Free service from 7:30 am to 7 pm from Monday to Friday and on Saturday from 10 am to 7:30 pm
- □ 1 350 m trip along the Saône river, with 5 stops













ASSESSMENT OF THE EXPERIMENTATION

- lacktriangle A project that extends over time (3rd year of operation):
 - -+ 50,000 passengers carried
 - ■+ 38 500 km covered
- The passengers were curious and satisfied by the quality of the "silent and fluid" journey
- Continuous learning and actions implemented on a regular basis following passenger's feedback
- A deep interest in the autonomous shuttle: 93% of passengers think that this solution should be extended in urban areas*.
